BARBARA MOAKLER BYRNE, CLASS OF 1976, the Alumnae Association is pleased to honor you with the Achievement Award. This award is presented to alumnae whose accomplishments and service to society exemplify the values and virtues set forth by the College.

Barbara, you are a trailblazer for women in the investment banking arena. After beginning your career at Mobil Corporation, in 1988 you moved to Lehman Brothers, where you advised companies from diverse industries in rapidly changing market and technology environments. In 2004 you were the first woman to be named vice chairman at the company. You joined Barclays Capital in 2008, and you were the first woman to be named vice chairman, for the second time in your career. While at Barclays you helped lead the company's engagement with the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland, and served on the Gender Parity Task Force.

Throughout your career, you have served as a trusted advisor to leaders of global companies and organizations, and your judgment has been sought by CEOs and corporate boards as you led efforts that pioneered unique financial and team approaches to corporate challenges. Your focus on transparent communication has helped to build partnerships with integrity and resilience to achieve strategic goals. Paving the way for women in the investment banking field, you have been named by American Banker as one of the top five of the 25 Most Powerful Women in Finance for eight consecutive years. You also received the American Banker Lifetime Achievement Award in Finance.

Barbara, for your outstanding accomplishments, the Alumnae Association is honored to present you with the Achievement Award on this, your forty-fifth, reunion.
